Total annual budget for both utilities: \$412 million











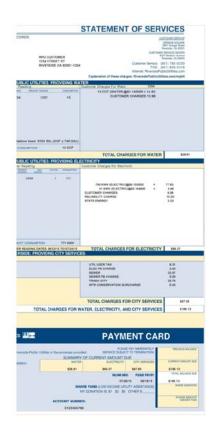

Investigates service diversion



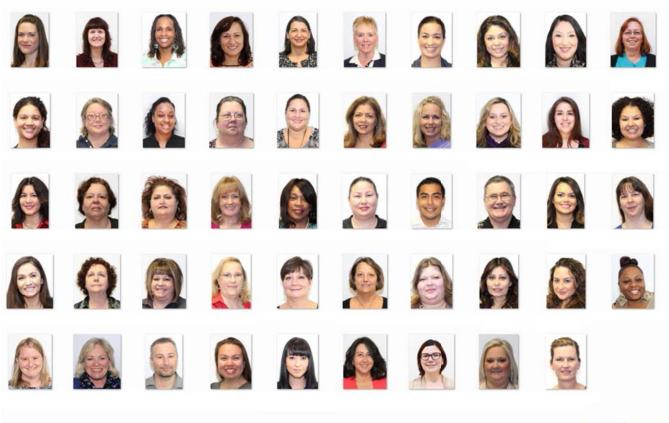

In 2014: 347,000 calls - 224,000 walk-ins



















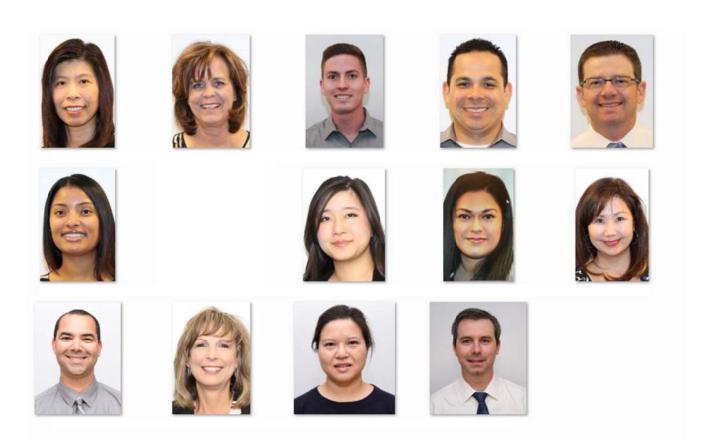

Completed the Tequesquite Landfill solar PPA

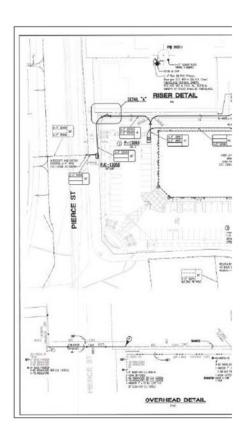
