SUBJECT: ACCESS TO CARE: MOLINA HEALTHCARE

ISSUE:

Receive information about Molina Healthcare services.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the Commission receive a presentation from a representative of Molina Healthcare.

BACKGROUND:

The mission of the Commission on Disabilities (COD) requires that they identify the needs of persons with disabilities and create a public awareness of these needs in the areas, including but not limited to, employment, housing, transportation, media, physical and communication accessibility.

The State of California requires mandatory enrollment of Medi-Cal clients into one of two managed care providers, Molina Healthcare (Molina) or Inland Empire Health Plan (IEHP) to provide continuity of care and minimize fraud. Molina's mission is to provide quality health services to financially vulnerable families and individuals covered by government programs. Molina will present their health plans, medical clinics and health information management solutions to the COD.
