**LOCATION:** 195 Orange Street

PROPOSAL: The Cultural Heritage Board recommends designation of the Trujillo Adobe located 220 feet northwest of Center Street and Orange Street intersection as a City Landmark. Staff recommends amending Title 19, Zoning Code Map, of the Riverside Municipal Code, to rezone the subject property to apply the CR - Cultural Resources Overlay Zone to the existing Public Facilities Zone.


ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: The Cultural Heritage Board recommends finding that the proposed project is categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) per Sections 15061(b)(3) and 15308 of the CEQA guidelines as it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity will have a significant effect on the environment, said action is intended to preserve the historic character of the building and site, and to provide notice of the historic status.
