Why I would like to serve on a Board or Commission:

I have worked on police accountability since January 1999. When Tyisha Miller was killed by Riverside Police Department officers in December 1998, I had only lived in Riverside for about two years, and I had a deep and immediate response to her death: as an educator, I realized that Tyisha Miller could have been any of my students, who are mostly young people of color. I organized a public forum at UCR on police accountability three weeks after Miller's death in which I called for a civilian review board for the RPD. I learned that others in the Riverside community had come to the same conclusion. Community meetings ensued and I was a founding member of the Riverside Coalition for Police Accountability (RCPA).

The effort continues: the CPRC is a work in progress and will only be as effective as the community helps it to be. Working on police accountability has taught me about the challenges and rewards of working cooperatively with other community groups. It has also opened up Riverside to me as a complex city of many different communities and contending agendas. I have learned that a few people working closely together with commitment and respect for differences can accomplish quite a lot. Riverside is a large city in terms of population but its infrastructures are small enough so that the community can still access the leaders who create change (or who stand in the way of it).

1 believe that the CPRC is at a crossroads. It is 6 years old, has had several Executive Directors, and now has a new Manager. Only a few founding Commission members still serve and there has been considerable turnover in Commission members in the past 8 months. I would be honored to serve and would be particularly committed to working on community outreach.


