














Comprehensive Energy Package

 - Policy items to be address in a comprehensive package include: Reduction of GHG emissions, Increased energy efficiency, Economic Development, grid reliability, Cyber Security





HOWEVER,

- President Obama signed a transportation bill (H.R. 22 FAST Act) that included measures aimed at firming the U.S. electric grid against attacks and outages, and includes plans to develop a strategic reserve of transmission equipment, Smart Grid News reports.
- H.R. 22 gives the President authority to declare a grid emergency in response to physical or cyber attacks, electromagnetic pulses or a geomagnetic storm.


