SUBJECT: BOARD OF PUBLIC UTILITIES INTERVIEWS

ISSUE:

The issue for the Mayor and City Council is to conduct interviews for appointments to the Board of Public Utilities for the March 1, 2016, annual board and commission recruitment.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

That the Mayor and City Council:

1. Interview applicants for the Ward 2 seat on the Board of Public Utilities for a term through March 1, 2020; and
2. Interview applicants for the Citywide seat on the Board of Public Utilities for a term through March 1, 2018.

BACKGROUND:

On January 5, 2016, the City Council approved the Mayor's Nominating and Screening Committee recommendations for interviews for the March 1, 2016, annual board and commission annual recruitment for vacancies on the Community Police Review Commission, Planning Commission, and Board of Public Utilities.

Attempts to contact applicants Betty Ann Jefferson (Ward 2) and Lus D. Zamudio (Citywide) were not successful. They have been removed from the interview list.
