### **Biography**

I believe in challenging the status quo in almost everything I do. I think creatively and often differently. The way I challenge the status quo is by designing manufacturing processes that incorporate beautiful, innovative design and that are simple to operate and user friendly. My processes often integrate technology in surprising ways and are efficient, lean operations.

With a background in design, tool making, process engineering, along with deep experience with six sigma, lean principles, safety, and ergonomic design I bring a broad suite of tools to projects. I also like to work in the realm of the recently possible. I just happen to be in the manufacturing automation business.

Functioning as the bridge between technology and the business needs, I am the architect and implementer of advanced process systems for manufacturing. Currently, I've been deeply engaged in implementing conventional and collaborative robots, and advanced vision systems.

My other interests are laser processing of materials, anti-counterfeiting/grey marketing issues, and the IT grey space (the computing area between factory floor PLCs and the process or business LAN data). I improve manufacturing cost, quality, speed, and total throughput by implementing unique process solutions.

Looking towards new technologies that are ready or nearly ready to implement in manufacturing within the next two to four years I often track emergent technologies over time, until they are ready to roll out to the factory floor.

**Tooling Supervisor at 3M ESPE Irvine, CA:** June 1996 - March 1999

Supervised a team of skilled craft persons. As a service organization the focus was insuring daily production and operational issues were identified and mitigated. As the organizational leader for the tooling and hardwoods group responsible for identifying and implementing solutions to gaps in skill sets as well as negotiating general human resource issues.

Acquired and Implemented a four axis CNC mill, a Mori Seiki, which incorporates a Lemoine digitizing probe system. This system was designed to capture data from human teeth for the purpose of manufacturing dental crowns.

Process engineer responsible for an high volume electronics connector and semi-conductor chip handling system manufacturer. Front line engineer with complete technical responsibilities including: mold design, mold validation, process optimization, process validation, and process transfer.

Traveled extensively to mold tooling suppliers and outsourced parts vendors to troubleshoot 3M product processes on remote sites as well as to train suppliers. Started molding operations in Seremban Malaysia, for 3M Electronic Products Division. Acquired process equipment, materials and trained local talent in operations. 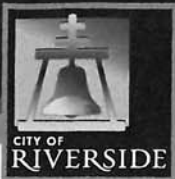

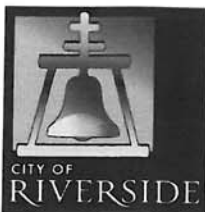

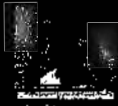
