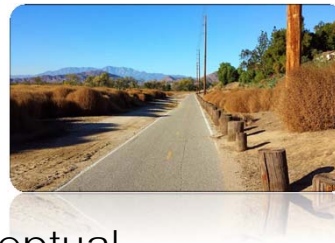

SANTA ANA RIVER TASK FORCE

1. Santa Ana River Task Force convened in 2003 and 2009.
2. Created a plan and conceptual framework that identified recreational and environmental opportunities for the river segment in Riverside.

SANTA ANA RIVER TASK FORCE

3. Called for a coordinated action plan that identifies and prioritizes the most viable projects and possible funding opportunities to allow for implementation of the plan.
4. Emphasis on improving existing parks along trail.
5. Discussion of trail adjacent economic development.

PROGRESS & UPDATES

1. Trail is complete through Riverside.
2. Focus on maintenance, improving access points, support amenities, and signage.
3. Active Transportation Program (ATP) Cycle I Grant specifically focused in the Mt. Rubidoux and Tequesquite Ave area. Focused on improving cycling connectivity to the Santa Ana River Trail.

PROGRESS & UPDATES

4. Upcoming project funded by a State Parks grant: provide trailhead support amenities (benches, drinking water, shade) where the trail passes Carlson Park.
5. Upcoming project to raise levee at City water treatment plant. Design is 90% complete. Construction will require a trail detour.
