

1 RESOLUTION NO.

2 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE,
3 CALIFORNIA, AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 22451 KNOWN AS THE
4 MASTER PARKING SCHEDULE RESOLUTION TO REMOVE THE
5 EXISTING 2-HOUR PARKING ZONE ON BOTH SIDES OF BROCKTON
6 AVENUE FROM MISSION INN AVENUE (FORMERLY SEVENTH
7 STREET) TO UNIVERSITY AVENUE.

8 WHEREAS, the Public Works Department received a petition from 100% of the
9 properties on Brockton Avenue between Mission Inn (formerly Seventh Street) and University
10 Avenues to remove the existing 2-Hour Parking Zone to provide additional on-street parking
11 opportunities for business patrons, employees and residents; and

12 WHEREAS, the existing restrictions were enacted years ago to promote turn-over of
13 parking spaces for area businesses; and

14 WHEREAS, the area parking needs have since changed and removal of the existing 2-
15 Hour Parking restriction would provide desired long-term on-street parking for residents and
16 businesses and better meet the current on-street parking demands for the area; and

17 WHEREAS, on April 6, 2016, the Transportation Board approved staff's recommendation
18 to remove the existing 2-Hour Parking Zone on both sides of Brockton Avenue from Mission Inn
19 Avenue (formerly Seventh Street) to University Avenue.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Riverside,
21 California, as follows:

22 Section 1: The recitals set forth above are incorporated herein by reference.

23 Section 2: That the Master Parking Schedule is hereby amended by removing the existing
24 "2-Hour Parking between the hours of 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. of any day except Sunday and
25 holidays" Zone on both sides of Brockton Avenue from Mission Inn Avenue (formerly Seventh
26 Street) to University Avenue from the Master Parking Schedule;

27 Section 3: That the provisions of this resolution shall be operative only when signs are
28 erected on that portion of the street set forth in Section 2 above, giving notice of the parking
limitations or prohibitions herein established.

Section 4: The provisions of this amendment shall be operative as of the date of adoption of this resolution.
