SUBJECT: ANNUAL APPROPRIATIONS LIMIT - RESOLUTION

### **ISSUE:**

The issue for City Council consideration is adoption of a Resolution to establish the 2016/17 Appropriations Limit as required by Article XIIIB of the State Constitution.

## **RECOMMENDATION:**

That the City Council adopt a Resolution establishing the 2016/17 Appropriations Limit of \$307,155,212.

### **BACKGROUND:**

An annual appropriations limit established by City Council Resolution is required as a result of the 1979 Proposition 4, Gann Initiative, Article XIIIB of the State Constitution and Section 7910 of the Government Code.

The appropriations limit for the City of Riverside is calculated to be \$307,155,212 for Fiscal Year 2016/17. Documentation showing the calculations made to arrive at the appropriations limit has been available in the Finance Department for review by the public for at least 15 days.
