SUBJECT: BID NO. 7392 - RIVERSIDE WATER QUALITY CONTROL PLANT (WQCP) – AWARD OF CONTRACT FOR SECURITY FENCING TO ALCORN FENCING FOR \$379,460

ISSUE:

The issue for City Council consideration is to award a construction contract for the installation of security fencing at the Water Quality Control Plant, to Alcorn Fencing for \$379,460.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the City Council award a construction contract for Bid No. 7392 – Riverside WQCP Security Fencing to Alcorn Fencing, of Sun Valley, California, in the amount of \$379,460.

BACKGROUND:

The WQCP shares approximately 2,860 linear feet of a six-foot high chain link fence along the southern property line with adjacent businesses. However, over the years this fence has become old and dilapidated, and does not provide the necessary security from intruders.

The 2014 Capital Improvement Program and Rate Study identified this perimeter fencing to be replaced. Staff designed construction plans to replace the old chain link fencing with new eight foot high tubular steel fencing. This fencing will match the same style and color as the steel fencing the County of Riverside installed along Van Buren Boulevard between Jurupa Avenue and the Santa Ana River.

On May 3, 2016, four bids were received for the security fencing project. One bidder did not meet the requirements of the specification and was deemed non-responsive. The lowest responsive bid was from Alcorn Fencing Company, in the amount of \$379,460, which is 8.6% below the Engineer's estimate.

The Purchasing Services Manager concurs with the recommendation above.

FISCAL IMPACT:

There is no impact to the General Fund. Sufficient funds are available in the Public Works Department WQCP Security System Upgrades Account No. 9763423 – 440301 to award this Project.
