



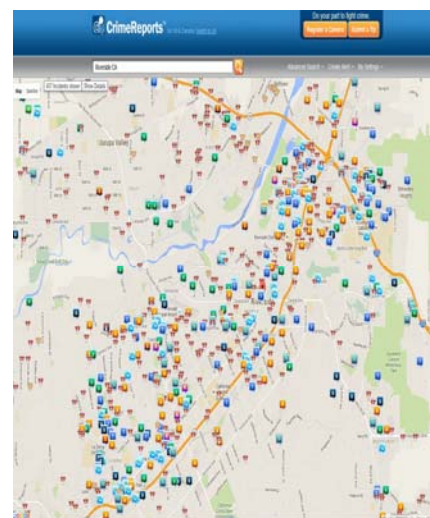





## University area residents – UCR Student housing issues

**CURBING 'CUTUPS'**

Riverside will consider new zoning to address concerns about landlords turning living rooms into extra bedrooms to pack more tenants into single-family homes.

**What:** The "overlay zone" would require that bedroom space be no greater than common living space such as kitchens and living rooms. Homes with more than four bedrooms would need more parking.

**Where:** The new zoning would apply to single family-zoned portions of the University and Canyon Crest neighborhoods

In 2003, the Riverside City Council established the **Neighborhood Livability Program (NLP)** and a **MULTI-DEPARTMENT TASK FORCE** to enhance existing code enforcement efforts to maintain and improve the **SAFETY – CLEANLINESS – AESTHETIC APPEARANCE** of Riverside's Neighborhoods using a **PROACTIVE – INTENSIVE – FOCUSED – PROBLEM SOLVING APPROACH**

with input from the community and involvement of State and County regulatory Agencies when appropriate.
