

**CITY OF RIVERSIDE  
AMENDED NOTICE OF PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD FOR  
AMENDMENT OF THE 2014-15 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN**

NOTICE IS HEREBY given that on Tuesday, July 12, 2016, at 7 p.m., or thereafter (not June 14, 2016, as previously advertised), the City Council of the City of Riverside will meet in the Art Pick Council Chamber, City Hall, 3900 Main Street, Riverside, California to consider comments from the public and to approve an amendment to the 2014-2015 Annual Action Plan.

The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) approved the City of Riverside's Five-Year Consolidated Plan in 2010. The Consolidated Plan provides an inventory of existing programs and activities, resources, demographics, unmet needs and identifies strategies and resources such as Community Development Block Grant funds (CDBG), HOME Investment Partnerships Program (HOME), Housing Opportunities for People with AIDS (HOPWA), and Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) needed to implement programs and activities to address the unmet needs. With the approval of the Consolidated Plan, it is the Annual Action Plan that incrementally addresses and implements identified programs and activities prepared and submitted to HUD for approval. The Annual Action Plan prepared for 2014-2015 implements the strategies and goals identified in the Consolidated Plan.


Federal Regulations 24 CFR 91.105 requires the City to notify and provide its citizens an opportunity to comment and provide input on proposed changes to an approved plan. This notice serves this purpose and allows the City to comply with the law. The proposed amendment to the approved Plan affected by this Notice is the City's proposal to undertake the following activity:

- Allocate HOME funds in an amount not-to-exceed \$837,001 for the Tenant Based Rental Assistance Program to provide rental assistance and security and utility deposits to homeless individuals and very low income families and seniors.

Both oral and written comments may be submitted for this item no later than July 6, 2016, by 5 p.m. Anyone interested may provide input and comments to the City of Riverside Community & Economic Development Department, Third Floor, 3900 Main Street, Riverside, CA 92522.
