

1 RESOLUTION NO.

2 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
3 RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, RECITING THE FACT OF THE  
4 GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD IN SAID CITY ON  
5 THE 7th DAY OF JUNE, 2016, DECLARING THE RESULTS  
6 THEREOF AND SETTING FORTH SUCH OTHER MATTERS AS  
7 ARE PROVIDED BY LAW.

8 WHEREAS, a General Municipal Election was held and conducted in the City of  
9 Riverside on the 7th day of June, 2016, as required by law for the purpose of electing a Mayor  
10 of the City of Riverside and voting on Measures A and B; and

11 WHEREAS, notice of said election was duly and regularly given in the time, form and  
12 manner as provided by law; voting precincts were properly established; election officers were  
13 appointed and in all respects said election was held and the returns made and declared in the  
14 time, form, and manner as required by the provisions of the Charter of the City of Riverside and  
15 the Elections Code of the State of California for the holding of public elections in the City of  
16 Riverside; and

17 WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 22948 adopted on the 12th day of January, 2016,  
18 Resolution No. 22967 adopted on the 9th day of February, 2016, and Resolution No. 22979  
19 adopted on the 8th day of March, 2016, the appropriate County official canvassed the returns of  
20 said election and has certified the results to this City Council and said results are received,  
21 attached, and made a part hereof as Exhibit "A".

22 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Riverside, as  
23 follows:

24 Section 1: That there were eighty-six (86) voting precincts established for the  
25 purpose of holding said election consisting of the consolidation of the regular election precincts  
26 in the City of Riverside as established for the holding of state and county elections.

27 Section 2: That said General Municipal election was held for the purpose of electing  
28 a Mayor of the City of Riverside and for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors of the  
City of Riverside the questions as to whether proposed Charter amendments known as Measures  
A and B and more particularly described in Attachment "A" Section 1 of Resolution No. 22966

1 and Resolution No. 22978 of the City of Riverside, should be approved.

2 Section 3: That the whole number of votes cast in said City election, excepting  
3 therefrom vote by mail ballots was \_\_\_\_; that the whole number of vote by mail ballots cast in  
4 said City election was \_\_\_\_; and that the total of all votes cast in said City election was \_\_\_\_.

5 Section 4: That the names of the persons voted for at said election and the office  
6 which each person was voted for are as follows:

15 That the number of votes given at each precinct and the number of votes given in the  
16 City to each of said persons above named for the respective offices for which said persons were  
17 candidates are listed on the attached Exhibit "A".

18 Section 5: That the City Council does declare and determine that Rusty Bailey was  
19 elected Mayor of said City to serve for the full term of four years.

20 Section 6: That on the ballots used at said Election the following Measures were  
21 submitted to the electors of said City:

22 **MEASURE A – Measure Failed**

23 *Shall Section 702 of the City Charter be amended to establish that the Office of City*  
24 *Prosecutor be created within the City Attorney's Office, and the City Attorney acts as*  
25 *City Prosecutor and charged with the duty on behalf of the people of prosecuting*  
26 *misdemeanor offenses arising out of violations of state law?*
