

Recovery for Unpaid Accounts of Fines, Penalties and Costs of Abatements for Fiscal Year 2015-16

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BACKGROUND INFORMATION

- The Administrative Code Enforcement Program was adopted by the City Council on July 13, 1999, establishing a means for cost recovery for Code Enforcement processes.
- The City is required to conduct a public hearing on the nuisance abatement costs.
- Notice of Public Hearing was published in the Press Enterprise on June 28, 2016.



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CODE ENFORCEMENT STATISTICS

- For Fiscal Year 2015-16, the Code Enforcement Division has processed 9,204 cases.
- The total number of properties with uncollected abatement costs, administrative civil penalties and/or administrative citations under consideration today is 319 properties, approximately 2.88% of all cases.



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Summary of Fines

 The City would recover approximately \$1,608,470.49 in unpaid balances.
