

1 RESOLUTION NO. 16190

2 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
3 RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, ESTABLISHING A MAYOR'S
4 NOMINATING AND SCREENING COMMITTEE FOR PROCESSING
5 APPOINTMENTS TO CITY BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS TO
6 BECOME OPERATIVE IF A PROPOSED CHARTER AMENDMENT
7 GIVING THE MAYOR A VOTE ON THE NOMINATION AND
8 APPOINTMENT OF SUCH MEMBERS IS ADOPTED BY THE
9 VOTERS AT THE NOVEMBER 4, 1986 GENERAL ELECTION.

10 WHEREAS the City Council has proposed a Charter
11 Amendment giving the Mayor the additional power to vote on the
12 appointment of the members of the various formal boards and
13 commissions; and

14 WHEREAS the City Council is desirous of having the
15 Mayor take a more active role in the nomination and appointment
16 of said members; and

17 WHEREAS the City Council desires to formulate a
18 procedure for the nomination and appointment to become
19 operative if the Charter Amendment is adopted;

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of
21 the City of Riverside that the following procedure shall be
22 followed should the proposed Charter amendment giving the Mayor
23 a vote on the appointment of members to the various City boards
24 and commissions pass:

25 There is hereby created a Mayor's Nominating and
26 Screening Committee to be composed of the members of the City
27 Council Governmental Affairs Committee with the Mayor acting as
Chairman and voting with the councilmembers on any recommen-
dations to be made to the City Council. The Chairman of the
Governmental Affairs Committee shall act as Vice-Chairman to

1 act in the Mayor's absence or failure to act.

2 With respect to consideration of appointments to new
3 boards and commissions or the filling of vacancies when regular
4 full term appointments are made the following steps shall be
5 taken:

6 1. Notification of vacancies shall be made to the
7 residents by appropriate announcements and or advertising
8 during the month of July for regular October appointments and
9 as soon as practicable for any new board or commission.

10 2. Applications will be filed with the Mayor's office
11 and will be available for review by the Mayor and City
12 Councilmembers.

13 3. The Mayor or if he fails to act the Vice-Chairman
14 of the Committee shall call a meeting of the committee during
15 the month of August to formulate the procedure and schedule for
16 processing recommendations to the City Council.

17 4. Recommendations for appointment shall be forwarded
18 to the City Council prior to the first meeting in October.

19 With respect to other vacancies the Mayor, or if he
20 fails to act the Vice-Chairman, will call a meeting within ten
21 days after the City Council declares a vacancy at which time
22 the procedure and time constraints for filling the vacancy will
23 be set so that a recommendation will be made to the City
24 Council at a Council meeting less than 60 days after the
25 vacancy occurs.
