ISSUE

The League of California Cities 2016 Annual Conference is scheduled for October 5 - 7, 2016, and a voting delegate and alternate may be designated to represent the City at the annual business meeting on Friday, October 7, 2016.

RECOMMENDATION

That the City Council designate Mayor Bailey as the voting delegate and Councilmember Davis as alternate for the business meeting of the 2016 League of California Cities annual conference.

BACKGROUND

The League of California Cities (League) holds an annual conference and business meeting to take action on conference resolutions that guide cities and the League in efforts to improve the quality, responsiveness and vitality of local government in California. The City of Riverside has the opportunity to appoint a voting delegate and alternate to represent Riverside at the annual business meeting on Friday, October 7, 2016, in Long Beach.

Mayor Bailey and Councilmember Davis concur with these appointments.

FISCAL IMPACT

The conference travel and meeting expenses are included in the Mayor and City Council adopted budgets. There is no additional funding needed to designate a voting representative or to perform the duties.
