- Population of 36 million
- 37% California, 21% Texas
- 15% Los Angeles, 6% Chicago, 5% Houston
- Mexicans in the US generate 8% of the GDP
- 8 million US jobs depend directly on the economic activity created by undocumented workers

- Daily Trade: 1.3 billion dollars
- Mexico's exports to the world have 40% U.S. content
- 6 million U.S. jobs depend on trade with Mexico
- 1 in 25 businesses are owned by Mexican immigrants





- Hispanics represent the largest minority market
- Hispanics purchasing power surpassed \$1.5 trillion dollars
- Mexican immigrants send to Mexico less than 14% of their monthly income in remittances
- 70% of immigrants arrive to the US during their working age
- Through tax payment and social security contributions, immigrants pay around \$90 billion, and only use \$5 billion in public services
