A RESOLUTION OF THE OVERSIGHT BOARD FOR CITY OF RIVERSIDE AS SUCCESSOR AGENCY TO THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE APPROVING A THIRD AMENDMENT TO PROFESSIONAL CONSULTANT SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH AMEC FOSTER WHEELER ENVIRONMENT & INFRASTRUCTURE, INC. TO INCREASE THE COMPENSATION AND FOR ADDITIONAL PHASE II ENVIRONMENTAL SITE ASSESSMENT AND PREPARATION OF A REMEDIAL ACTION PLAN.

WHEREAS, on January 10, 2012, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 22322 reaffirming the authorization of the City of Riverside to become Successor Agency to the Redevelopment Agency of the City of Riverside ("Successor Agency") pursuant to ABx1 26; and

WHEREAS, subsequent legislation entitled "Assembly Bill 1484", signed into law on June 27, 2012, makes substantive amendments to ABx1 26 and specifically includes a requirement, set forth at Health & Safety Code section 34179(e), that all actions taken by the oversight board be adopted by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Successor Agency entered into a Professional Consultant Services Agreement with AMEC Foster Wheeler Environment & Infrastructure, Inc., formerly known as AMEC Environmental & Infrastructure, Inc. ("Consultant") on June 19, 2012 for Additional Phase II Environmental Site Assessment and preparation of a Remedial Action Plan ("Agreement") for the period from June 19, 2012 through December 31, 2012; and

WHEREAS, Successor Agency and Consultant agreed to extend the term of the Agreement to terminate on December 31, 2013 pursuant to a "First Amendment to the Professional Consultant Services Agreement"; and

WHEREAS, Successor Agency and Consultant agreed to add additional services, increase the compensation and extend the term of the Agreement until the Remedial Action Plan ("RAP") is approved by the California Water Quality Control Board, Santa Ana Region, pursuant to a "Second Amendment to the Professional Consultant Services Agreement" dated October 2, 2014; and

WHEREAS, Successor Agency and Consultant desire to increase the compensation on the Agreement by an additional One Hundred Seventy Nine Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$179,500) to Three Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$350,000), and to extend the term of the Agreement until
