SUBJECT: SANTA ANA RIVER TRAIL AND PARKWAY PROJECT UPDATE

ISSUE:

Receive an update from Principal Consultant Patricia Lock-Dawson regarding the Santa Ana River Trail and Parkway Project.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the City Council receive and file the Santa Ana River Trail and Parkway Project update.

BACKGROUND:

In 2006, leaders from Orange, Riverside, and San Bernardino counties and cities formed the Santa Ana River Trail and Parkway Partnership, a regional collaboration of the cities and counties adjacent to the Santa Ana River, working together to complete a 100-mile-long trail from crest to coast. The trail is approximately 60 percent complete with plans to complete the remaining portions over the next five years. The trail allows for a wide range of recreational activities.

DISCUSSION:

Principal Consultant to the Partnership Patricia Lock-Dawson will present an update on funding and construction progress and timelines.
