SUBJECT: REMOVAL OF SEGMENT OF NO PARKING ZONE ON INDIANA AVENUE – RESOLUTION

ISSUE:

Removal of the segment of the existing No Parking Any Time Zone on Indiana Avenue from Myers Street to Harrison Street.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the City Council adopt a resolution to remove the segment of the existing “No Parking Any Time” Zone on both sides of Indiana Avenue from Myers Street to Harrison Street.

BOARD RECOMMENDATION:

On August 3, 2016, the Transportation Board (Board) reviewed this matter; five of nine members were present. The Board unanimously recommended approval of the proposal to remove the segment of the existing No Parking Any Time Zone on both sides of Indiana Avenue from Myers Street to Harrison Street.

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION:

The recently completed Indiana Avenue Repaving Project included restriping between Myers Street and Harrison Street to provide a two-way left-turn lane and allow for on-street parking adjacent to the residential and commercial properties on Indiana Avenue within this segment of roadway. As a result, no parking signage on Indiana Avenue from Myers Street to Harrison Street was removed upon project completion.

The existing No Parking Any Time Zone will remain in effect on Indiana Avenue from Van Buren Boulevard to Myers Street. Removal of the proposed segment of the No Parking Any Time Zone is necessary to update the Master Parking Schedule and accurately reflect the remaining portions of the zone.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The cost of sign removal and relocation is approximately \$150.00 and will be funded from the existing Public Works Department budget.
