## RECOMMENDATION

That the City Council:

1. Accept the SNAP-Ed NEOP Sub-Grant Allocation from the Riverside University Health System - Public Health for the administration of NEOP for the federal fiscal years of 2017 through 2019;
2. Authorize an increase in estimated revenues during federal fiscal year 2017 (\$520,231.49), federal fiscal year 2018 (\$460,152.07), and federal fiscal year 2019 (\$416,268.45), to be offset by expenditures in the same amount into a project account as established by the Finance Department.

## RECOMMENDATION

3. Authorize the City Manager, or his designee, to execute all grant documents including making minor and non-substantive changes, to accept the a three year SNAP-Ed NEOP subgrant allocation from the Riverside University Health System - Public Health to the City of Riverside for \$1,396,652.01, including making minor and non-substantive changes.
4. Authorize the City Manager, or his designee, to execute the Memorandum of Understanding with Alvord Unified School District, including making minor and non-substantive changes, sub-granting Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program Education funds in the amount of \$61,000 for federal fiscal year 2017;

## RECOMMENDATION

5. Authorize the City Manager, or his designee, to execute the Memorandum of Understanding with Riverside Unified School District, including making minor and non-substantive changes, sub-granting Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program Education funds in the amount of \$108,000 for federal fiscal year 2017; and
6. Authorize the City Manager, or his designee, to the Memorandum of Understanding with the Parks, Recreation, and Community Services Department of the City of Riverside, including making minor and non-substantive changes, sub-granting Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program Education funds in the amount of \$130,000 for federal fiscal year 2017.
