A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, ORDERING THE REORGANIZATION TO THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE OF THAT CERTAIN CONTIGUOUS UNINHABITED TERRITORY KNOWN AS "ANNEXATION 118 – CENTRAL/SYCAMORE CANYON, GENERALLY LOCATED NORTHERLY OF CENTRAL AVENUE AND SOUTHWESTERLY OF STATE ROUTE 60, INTERSTATE 215 FREEWAY" AND DESIGNATED AS "LAFCO NO. 2015-08-1 REORGANIZATION TO INCLUDE ANNEXATION 118 (CENTRAL SYCAMORE CANYON) TO THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE AND CONCURRENT ANNEXATION TO NORTHWEST MOSQUITO AND VECTOR CONTROL DISTRICT AND CONCURRENT DETACHMENTS FROM COUNTY SERVICE AREA 93 AND THE RIVERSIDE COUNTY WASTE RESOURCES MANAGEMENT DISTRICT"

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of the Cortese-Knox-Hertzberg Local Government Reorganization Act of 2000, being Division 3 of Title 5 of the Government Code of the State of California (commencing with Section 56000), proceedings were commenced by a resolution of the City of Riverside of that certain uninhabited territory known as "Annexation 14 118 – Central/Sycamore Canyon, generally located northerly of Central Avenue and southwesterly of the State Route 60, Interstate 215 freeway"; and

WHEREAS, on June 23, 2016, the Riverside County Local Agency Formation 16 Commission by its Resolution No. 05-16 approved the reorganization to include Annexation 118 17 to the City of Riverside, and Concurrent Annexation to the Northwest Mosquito and Vector 18 Control District and Concurrent Detachments from County Service Area 93 and the Riverside 19 County Waste Resources Management District, of the approximately 16.6 acres generally 20located northerly of Central Avenue and southwesterly of the State Route 60, Interstate 215 21 freeway under the designation "LAFCO No. 2015-08-1 Reorganization to Include Annexation 22 118 (Central/Sycamore Canyon) to the City of Riverside and Concurrent Annexation to the 23 Northwest Mosquito and Vector Control District and Concurrent Detachments from County 24 Service Area 93 and the Riverside County Waste Resources Management District"; and 25

WHEREAS, pursuant to Government Code Section 56663(c), protest proceedings were waived as the affected territory is uninhabited and the proposal has the consent of 100 percent of the affected landowners; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Riverside,
 California, as follows:

3 Section 1: That proceedings for reorganization to include the annexation to the City of Riverside of certain uninhabited territory known as "Annexation 118 - Central/Sycamore 4 Canyon, generally located northerly of Central Avenue and southwesterly of the State Route 60, 5 Interstate 215 freeway" and designated as "LAFCO No. 2015-08-1 Reorganization to Include 6 Annexation 118 (Central/Sycamore Canyon) to the City of Riverside and Concurrent Annexation 7 to the Northwest Mosquito and Vector Control District and Concurrent Detachments from 8 County Service Area 93 and the Riverside County Waste Resources Management District" have 9 been and are being taken pursuant to the provisions of the Cortese-Knox-Hertzberg Local 10 Government Reorganization Action of 2000, being Division 3 of Title 5 of the Government Code 11 of the State of California, and have been undertaken by petition of Eric Flodine of Strata Crest, 12 LLC, landowner. 13

Section 2: That the City Council finds and determines that the owners of land within the 14 territory proposed to be reorganized in the proceedings designated as ALAFCO No. 2015-08-1 15 Reorganization to Include Annexation 118 (Central/Sycamore Canyon) to the City of Riverside 16 and Concurrent Annexation to the Northwest Mosquito and Vector Control District and 17 18 Concurrent Detachments from County Service Area 93 and the Riverside County Waste 19 Resources Management District@ have given written consent to the annexation and that by its 20 Resolution No. 05-16, the Riverside County Local Agency Formation Commission authorized 21 the annexation to proceed without notice, hearing, or election.

Section 3: That the exterior boundaries of the territory to be reorganized and annexed to the
 City of Riverside and concurrently annexed to the Northwest Mosquito and Vector Control
 District and concurrently detached from County Service Area 93 and the Riverside County
 Waste Resources Management District as approved by the Riverside County Local Agency
 Formation Commission are legally described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated
 herein by reference.

Section 4: That by its Resolution No. 05-16, the Riverside County Local Agency Formation 1 2 Commission found 100 percent consent of affected landowners and ordered the reorganization to 3 the City of Riverside of that uninhabited territory designated as "LAFCO No. 2015-08-1 Reorganization to Include Annexation 118 (Central/Sycamore Canyon) to the City of Riverside 4 and Concurrent Annexation to the Northwest Mosquito and Vector Control District and 5 Concurrent Detachments from County Service Area 93 and the Riverside County Waste 6 Resources Management District" subject to its terms as set forth in said Resolution and 7 including: 8

a. The City of Riverside shall defend, indemnify, and hold harmless the Riverside 9 County Local Agency Formation Commission ("LAFCO"), its agents, officers, and employees 10 from any claim, action, or proceeding against LAFCO, its agents, officers, or employees to 11 attach, set aside, void, or annul an approval of LAFCO concerning LAFCO No. 2015-08-1 12 Reorganization to Include Annexation 118 (Central/Sycamore Canyon) to the City of Riverside 13 and Concurrent Annexation to the Northwest Mosquito and Vector Control District and 14 Concurrent Detachments from County Service Area 93 and the Riverside County Waste 15 Resources Management District. LAFCO will promptly notify the City of Riverside of any such 16 claim, action, or proceeding against LAFCO and will cooperate fully in the defense. If LAFCO 17 fails to promptly notify the City of Riverside of any such claim, action, or proceeding, or fails to 18 cooperate fully in the defense, City of Riverside shall not, thereafter, be responsible to defend, 19 indemnify, or hold harmless LAFCO. 20

b. In accordance with Government Code Sections 56886(t) and 57330, the subject
property shall be subject to the levying and collection of and previously authorized charge, fee,
assessment or tax of the City and the Northwest Mosquito and Vector Control District.

c. In accordance with Government Code Section 56375(n), waive any automatic detachment from Riverside County Service Area 152 based on the following findings:

i. County Service Area (CSA) 152 is a funding mechanism for the implementation of the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES)

emanating from the Federal 1972 Clean Water Act, and reauthorized under the 1 2 Federal 1987 Clean Water Act. ii. The City of Riverside annexed into CSA 152 and is included within the CSA's 3 service area. 4 iii. Detachment would deprive the area residents of services needed to ensure 5 their health, safety or welfare. 6 Waiving detachment will not affect the ability of the City or County to iv. 7 provide services. 8 <u>Section 5:</u> That the reasons for the reorganization designated as "LAFCO No. 2015-08-1 9 Reorganization to Include Annexation 118 (Central/Sycamore Canyon) to the City of Riverside 10 and Concurrent Annexation to the Northwest Mosquito and Vector Control District and 11 Concurrent Detachments from County Service Area 93 and the Riverside County Waste 12 Resources Management District" are as follows: to provide municipal services by the City of 13 Riverside to the territory proposed to be annexed. 14 Section 6: That the regular county assessment roll of the County of Riverside is utilized 15 by the City of Riverside and will be utilized in all proceedings connected with this reorganization 16 designated as "LAFCO No. 2015-08-1 Reorganization to Include Annexation 118 17 (Central/Sycamore Canyon) to the City of Riverside and Concurrent Annexation to the

18 (Central/Sycamore Canyon) to the City of Riverside and Concurrent Annexation to the
 19 Northwest Mosquito and Vector Control District and Concurrent Detachments from County
 20 Service Area 93 and the Riverside County Waste Resources Management District."

Section 7: That the property in the territory to be annexed to the City of Riverside and 21 designated as "LAFCO No. 2015-08-1 Reorganization to Include Annexation 118 22 (Central/Sycamore Canyon) to the City of Riverside and Concurrent Annexation to the 23 Northwest Mosquito and Vector Control District and Concurrent Detachments from County 24 Service Area 93 and the Riverside County Waste Resources Management District" shall be 25 subject, after such annexation, to taxation equally with the property within the City of Riverside. 26 More specifically, the property in the territory to be annexed shall be subject to the City of 27 Riverside's existing Street Light Assessment District. Pursuant to Howard Jarvis Tax Payers 28

 District is expressly exempt from the procedural requirements of Proposition 218 as set forth in
 Article XIII D, Section 5, Subdivision (a) of the California Constitution.

Section 8: The affected territory will be taxed for existing general bonded indebtedness.

<u>Section 9</u>: That the reorganization to the City of Riverside of that certain uninhabited
territory known as "Annexation 118 – Central/Sycamore Canyon, generally located northerly of
Central Avenue and southwesterly of the State Route 60, Interstate 215 freeway" and designated
as "LAFCO No. 2015-08-1 Reorganization to Include Annexation 118 (Central/Sycamore
Canyon) to the City of Riverside and Concurrent Annexation to the Northwest Mosquito and
Vector Control District and Concurrent Detachments from County Service Area 93 and the
Riverside County Waste Resources Management District" is hereby ordered.

<u>Section 11</u>: That the effective date of the annexation to the City of Riverside of the territory designated as "LAFCO No. 2015-08-1 Reorganization to Include Annexation 118 (Central/Sycamore Canyon) to the City of Riverside and Concurrent Annexation to the Northwest Mosquito and Vector Control District and Concurrent Detachments from County Service Area 93 and the Riverside County Waste Resources Management District" shall be September 2, 2016, which is the date the Certificate of Completion was recorded with the County Recorder.

Section 12: That the City Clerk of the City of Riverside is hereby authorized and directed
 to transmit a certified copy of this resolution together with the applicable fees required by
 Section 54902.5 of the Government Code to the Executive Officer of the Riverside County Local
 Agency Formation Commission.

REORGANIZATION TO INCLUDE ANNEXATION 118 (CENTRAL/SYCAMORE) TO THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE AND CONCURRENT ANNEXATION TO NORTHWEST MOSQUITO AND VECTOR CONTROL DISTRICT AND CONCURRENT DETACHMENT FROM COUNTY SERVICE AREA 93 AND THE RIVERSIDE COUNTY WASTE RESOURCES MANAGEMENT DISTRICT LAFCO 2015-08-1

That portion of Section 33, Township 2 South, Range 4, West, San Bernardino Base and Meridian, lying within an unincorporated area of the County of Riverside, State of California, more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at the intersection of the centerline of Central Avenue and the West line of Section 33, Township 2 South, Range 4 West, San Bernardino Base and Meridian as shown on Record of Survey, filed in Book 60, Page 66 of Records of Survey, Records of said County;

- THENCE along the West line of said section, North 00°14'03" East, a distance of 1014.55 feet to a point on the Southerly right of way line as shown on Caltrans Right of way map No. 982000-90, said point being the beginning of a non-tangent 1921.00 foot radius curve concave Southerly, a radial line bears North 06°36'12" East;
- (2) THENCE Easterly along said right of way line and the arc of said curve through a central angle of 06°29'07", a distance of 217.44 feet;
- (3) THENCE continuing along said right of way line the next seven (7) courses, South 70°17'59" East, a distance of 110.66 feet;
- (4) THENCE South 64°39'32" East, a distance of 74.86 feet;
- (5) THENCE South 58°25'40" East, a distance of 363.39 feet to the beginning of a non-tangent 920.00 foot radius curve concave Southwesterly, a radial line bears North 45°29'24" East;
- (6) THENCE Southeasterly along the arc of said curve through a central angle of 10°26'37", a distance of 167.68 feet;
- (7) THENCE South 34°03'59" East, a distance of 394.86 feet to the beginning of a tangent 478.94 foot radius curve concave Northeasterly;
- (8) THENCE Southeasterly along the arc of said curve through a central angle of 06°20'09", a distance of 52.96 feet;
- (9) THENCE South 59°17'48" East, a distance of 71.83 feet to a point on the centerline of said Central Avenue, said point being the beginning of a non-tangent 420.00 foot radius curve concave Northwesterly, a radial line bears South 36°12'50" East;

- (10) THENCE Southwesterly along said centerline and the arc of said curve through a central angle of 30°11'28", a distance of 221.31 feet;
- (11) THENCE continuing along said centerline, South 83°58'38" West, a distance of 796.05 feet to the beginning of a tangent 1200.00 foot radius curve concave Southerly;
- (12) THENCE continuing Westerly along said centerline and the arc of said curve through a central angle of 06°02'46", a distance of 126.63 feet to the **POINT OF BEGINNING**.


