HOMELESSNESS IN RIVERSIDE WORKSHOP OCTOBER 11, 2016

To address community livability concerns in the City of Riverside, the following regulations were adopted in the Riverside Municipal Code.

- 1. Section 5.08.020: Solicitation within the City of Riverside is unlawful where posted or otherwise communicated to the solicitor.
- 2. Section 9.04.010: Prohibition against certain forms of aggressive solicitation on streets and highways.
- 3. Section 9.04.120: Loitering to block an entrance or walkway.
- 4. Section 9.04.220: Loitering for drug activities.
- 5. Section 9.04.280: Annoying pedestrians--Impeding free passage.
- 6. Section 9.04.300: Trespass on private property.
- 7. Section 9.04.400: Conduct on public property. Also storing personal property on public property.
- 8. Section 9.04.500: Sitting or lying in entrance of building prohibited.
- 9. Section 9.04.600: Prohibits camping on public streets, sidewalks, and public property.
- 10. Section 9.08.070: Camping; Permit required in parks.
- 11. Section 9.08.110: Park hours and closure. In the parks after closed prohibited.
- 12. Section 9.08.140: Smoking prohibited in the park.
