


Condemnation of Southern California Edison Electrical Facilities and Real Property Interests in Annexation Areas 95 and 99

RESOLUTIONS OF NECESSITY

The Resolution of Necessity require the City Council to adopt and make four (4) findings. The required findings are as follow:


- I. Whether the public interest and necessity require the proposed project.
- II. Whether the proposed public project is planned and located in a manner that would be most compatible with the greatest public good and the least private injury.



CONTINUED - RESOLUTIONS OF NECESSITY

- III. Whether the property interests sought to be acquired is necessary for the proposed project
- IV. Whether the offer required by Section 7267.2 of the Government Code has been made to each of the owner of record.





RECOMMENDATIONS:

That the Board of Public Utilities:

- Notify the City Council that the transfer of ownership is exempt from CEQA; and
- 2. Authorize the City Council to adopt a Resolution of Necessity to approve the initiation of eminent domain proceedings to acquire electrical facilities and real property interests; and
- 3. Approve Work Order No. 170409 in the amount of \$443,800 for deposit into the State Condemnation Fund for the eminent domain process.
