History

- September 22, 2015 City Council Authorized a supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$300,000 for landscape demonstration projects to the 521 water conservation fund.
- On August 22, 2016 the Board of Public Utilities approved the Demonstration Garden project at the Janet Goeske Center and awarded the Design-Build Agreement to R.B. Development.
- October 24, 2016 staff is requesting the consideration of the Board of Utilities in accepting donations for this project.

Recommendations

That the Board of Public Utilities approve and recommend that the City Council:

- Accept the donation of high efficiency irrigation materials from the Toro Company in an amount not to exceed \$50,000 for use in constructing the demonstration garden at Streeter Park (Janet Goeske Center); and
- 2. Accept a grant in the amount \$2,500 from Audubon International Sustainable Communities Program for the demonstration garden at Streeter Park (Janet Goeske Center); and
- 3. Appropriate the funds in the amount of \$2,500 for the demonstration garden project in accounts established by City Finance.
