

1 RESOLUTION NO. 22288

2 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE,
3 CALIFORNIA, APPROVING THE APPLICATION FOR A RUBBERIZED
4 PAVEMENT GRANT PROGRAM UNDER THE TIRE RECYCLING,
5 CLEANUP, AND ENFORCEMENT GRANT PROGRAM; AUTHORIZING
6 THE FILING OF SAID APPLICATION WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF
7 RESOURCES RECYCLING AND RECOVERY (CALRECYCLE);
8 ACCEPTING SAID GRANT; AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF
9 THE NECESSARY DOCUMENTS.

10 WHEREAS, the State of California is faced with the significant challenge of diverting or
11 safely managing more than forty million reusable and waste tires generated each year; and

12 WHEREAS, millions of waste tires have been illegally dumped or stockpiled throughout the
13 state and pose potential threats to the public health and safety; and

14 WHEREAS, Public Resources Code sections 40000 et seq. authorize the Department of
15 Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle), formerly known as the California Integrated
16 Waste Management Board, to administer various Grant Programs (grants) in furtherance of the state
17 of California's (State) efforts to reduce, recycle and reuse solid waste generated in the State thereby
18 preserving landfill capacity and protecting public health and safety and the environment; and

19 WHEREAS, in 2002, the Legislature passed Senate Bill 1346, codified in Public Resources
20 Code section 42872.5, expanding the grant program to include awards to governmental agencies for
21 the funding of public works projects utilizing rubberized asphalt concrete; and

22 WHEREAS, CalRecycle has been delegated the responsibility of administering the grant
23 program within the state, including establishing necessary procedures governing the submission of
24 applications by prospective grantees for Rubberized Pavement (TRP) Grants; and

25 WHEREAS, said procedures established by CalRecycle require the City Council of the City
26 of Riverside ("City") to certify by resolution the approval of the City to apply for a Rubberized
27 Pavement (TRP) Grant; and

28 WHEREAS, if awarded a grant, the City will be required to execute an Agreement with the
State of California for development of the City's projects; and

WHEREAS, the City presently has paving projects which are eligible under the Rubberized
Pavement Grant Program.


1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Riverside does
2 hereby:

3 Section 1: Authorize the submittal of an application to CalRecycle for a Rubberized
4 Pavement Grant.


5 Section 2: Authorize the City Manager, or his designee, to execute in the name of the
6 City of Riverside, all necessary applications, contracts, agreements, amendments, and payment
7 requests hereto for the purpose of securing grant funds and to implement and carry out the purposes
8 specified in the grant application.

9 Section 3: The authority granted herein to the City Manager of the City shall be valid from
10 the date of adoption of this Resolution up to and including June 30, 2016.


