³ Participation in a regional application will not count as a grant when considering future grant awards.

⁴ Chip Seal Grants include grant numbers beginning with TCS and/or TRP.

GRANT TERM

The Grant Term starts on the date indicated in the Notice to Proceed (NTP) from CalRecycle and ends on April 1, 2018. The Final Progress Report and final Payment Request are due to CalRecycle no later than April 1, 2018.

Grant-eligible program expenditures may start no earlier than the date indicated in the NTP. Eligible program costs must be incurred no later than April 1, 2018.

ELIGIBLE COSTS

Eligible costs may be incurred only during the Grant Term, which starts on the date indicated in the NTP from CalRecycle and ends on April 1, 2018. Costs incurred prior to the date indicated in the NTP and/or after April 1, 2018, are not eligible for reimbursement. (See "Grant Term" for additional information).
