BACKGROUND

- 1. September 22, 2015 City Council Authorized a supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$300,000 for landscape demonstration projects to the 521 water conservation fund.
- 2. On August 22, 2016 the Board of Public Utilities approved the Demonstration Garden project at the Janet Goeske Center and awarded the Design-Build Agreement to R.B. Development.
- 3. October 24, 2016 Board of Utilities unanimously approved accepting donations for this project.

RECOMMENDATIONS

That the City Council:

- Accept the donation of high efficiency irrigation materials from the Toro Company in an amount not to exceed \$50,000 for use in constructing the demonstration garden at Streeter Park (Janet Goeske Center);
- 2. Accept a grant in the amount \$2,500 from Audubon International Sustainable Communities Program for the demonstration garden at Streeter Park (Janet Goeske Center); and
- 3. Appropriate the funds in the amount of \$2,500 for the demonstration garden project in accounts established by City Finance.
