PACHAPPA CAMP EVALUATION & RECOGNITION CRITERIA

Meets two recognition criteria listed in RMC Section 20.50.010(BB):

Criterion 1: Has anthropological, cultural, military, political, architectural, economic, scientific or technical, religious, experimental, or other value;

Criterion 2: The original physical feature(s) no longer exist to an appreciable extent;

RECOMMENDATION

That the City Council:

1. **Determine** that Planning Case P16-0342 (City Point of Cultural Interest Recognition) is categorically exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA);
