

1 RESOLUTION NO.

2 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE,
3 CALIFORNIA, AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 22288 REGARDING THE
4 RUBBERIZED PAVEMENT GRANT PROGRAM UNDER THE TIRE
RECYCLING, CLEANUP, AND ENFORCEMENT GRANT PROGRAM
(CALRECYCLE) BY EXTENDING THE TERM TO JUNE 30, 2021.

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6 WHEREAS, the State of California is faced with the significant challenge of diverting or
7 safely managing more than forty million reusable and waste tires generated each year; and

8 WHEREAS, millions of waste tires have been illegally dumped or stockpiled throughout the
9 state and pose potential threats to the public health and safety; and

10 WHEREAS, Public Resources Code sections 40000 et seq. authorize the Department of
11 Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle), to administer various Grant Programs (grants) in
12 furtherance of the state's efforts to reduce, recycle and reuse solid waste generated in the State
13 thereby preserving landfill capacity and protecting public health and safety and the environment; and

14 WHEREAS, in 2002, the Legislature passed Senate Bill 1346, codified in Public Resources
15 Code section 42872.5, expanding the grant program to include awards to governmental agencies for
16 the funding of public works projects utilizing rubberized asphalt concrete; and

17 WHEREAS, CalRecycle has been delegated the responsibility of administering the grant
18 program within the state, including establishing necessary procedures governing the submission of
19 applications by prospective grantees for Rubberized Pavement (TRP) Grants; and

20 WHEREAS, the City presently has paving projects which are eligible under the Rubberized
21 Pavement Grant Program; and

22 WHEREAS, the amendment of Resolution No. 22288 will allow the City Manager, or his
23 designee, to execute the grant agreement and subsequent grant requests and agreements; and

24 WHEREAS, the Public Works Department applied for \$70,000.00 of FY 2017/2018 grant
25 funds to be utilized for upcoming preservation projects; and

26 WHEREAS, the authority granted to the City Manager expired on June 30, 2016; and

27 WHEREAS, the City desire's to extend the authority granted to the City Manager to June 30,
28 2021, and to accept additional grant funding.

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Riverside does
2 hereby:

3 Section 1: Resolution No. 22288 is hereby amended to extend the authority granted
4 therein to the City Manager, or his designee, of the City to be valid from the date of adoption of
5 Resolution No. 22288 up to and including June 30, 2021.

6 Section 2: All other authorization under Resolution No. 22288 remain in full force and
7 effect.
