A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 22288 REGARDING THE RUBBERIZED PAVEMENT GRANT PROGRAM UNDER THE TIRE RECYCLING, CLEANUP, AND ENFORCEMENT GRANT PROGRAM (CALRECYCLE) BY EXTENDING THE TERM TO JUNE 30, 2021.

WHEREAS, the State of California is faced with the significant challenge of diverting or safely managing more than forty million reusable and waste tires generated each year; and

WHEREAS, millions of waste tires have been illegally dumped or stockpiled throughout the state and pose potential threats to the public health and safety; and

WHEREAS, Public Resources Code sections 40000 et seq. authorize the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle), to administer various Grant Programs (grants) in furtherance of the state's efforts to reduce, recycle and reuse solid waste generated in the State thereby preserving landfill capacity and protecting public health and safety and the environment; and

WHEREAS, in 2002, the Legislature passed Senate Bill 1346, codified in Public Resources Code section 42872.5, expanding the grant program to include awards to governmental agencies for the funding of public works projects utilizing rubberized asphalt concrete; and

WHEREAS, CalRecycle has been delegated the responsibility of administering the grant program within the state, including establishing necessary procedures governing the submission of applications by prospective grantees for Rubberized Pavement (TRP) Grants; and

WHEREAS, the City presently has paving projects which are eligible under the Rubberized Pavement Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the amendment of Resolution No. 22288 will allow the City Manager, or his designee, to execute the grant agreement and subsequent grant requests and agreements; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department applied for \$70,000.00 of FY 2017/2018 grant funds to be utilized for upcoming preservation projects; and

WHEREAS, the authority granted to the City Manager expired on June 30, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the City desire's to extend the authority granted to the City Manager to June 30, 2021, and to accept additional grant funding.
