## **ISSUE:**

Approve award Bid No. 7449 to Raceway Ford of Riverside, California, for the purchase of six (6) 2017 Ford Police Interceptor SUV pursuit vehicles in the amount of \$187,034.52.

## **RECOMMENDATION:**

That the City Council award Bid No. 7449 to Raceway Ford of Riverside, California, for the purchase of six (6) 2017 Ford Police Interceptor SUV pursuit vehicles in the amount of \$187,034.52.

## **BACKGROUND:**

On November 10, 2016, the City's Purchasing Division posted Bid No. 7449 for the purchase of six (6) 2017 Ford Police Interceptor SUV pursuit vehicles. The City received two proposals. Raceway Ford was the lowest bidder with a bid of \$187,034.52, including tax and tire fee.

The Purchasing Services Manager concurs with the recommendation above.
