SUBJECT: MAYOR'S COMMISSION ON AGING APPOINTMENT

ISSUE:

Appoint Wilma C. VanGundy to the Mayor's Commission on Aging.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the Mayor and City Council appoint Wilma C. VanGundy to the Citywide seat on the Mayor's Commission on Aging for a term through March 1, 2017, and reappoint for a first full term through March 1, 2021.

BACKGROUND/LEGISLATIVE HISTORY:

Pursuant to Charter Section 802, each board and commission must have at least one representative from each of the Council Wards. The Mayor's Commission on Aging is comprised of seven ward-specific and two Citywide seats. Following current policy, the Mayor reviews applications on file and forwards a recommendation to the City Council for Citywide vacancies.

Mayor Bailey recommends appointment of Wilma C. VanGundy to a Citywide seat on the Mayor's Commission on Aging to fill an unexpired term through March 1, 2017, due to the resignation of Bob Reeves and to the subsequent full four-year term through March 1, 2021. This appointment fills the seat by a registered voter in compliance with Charter Section 802.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Recruitment and appointment costs are included annually in the City Clerk's budget.
