

He is a member of the National Academy of Sciences and the British Academy, and past president of the American Political Science Association. He has received numerous scholarly honors, including the Skkytte Prize, the most prestigious global award in political science, and the National Humanities Medal, the nation's highest honor for contributions to the humanities.

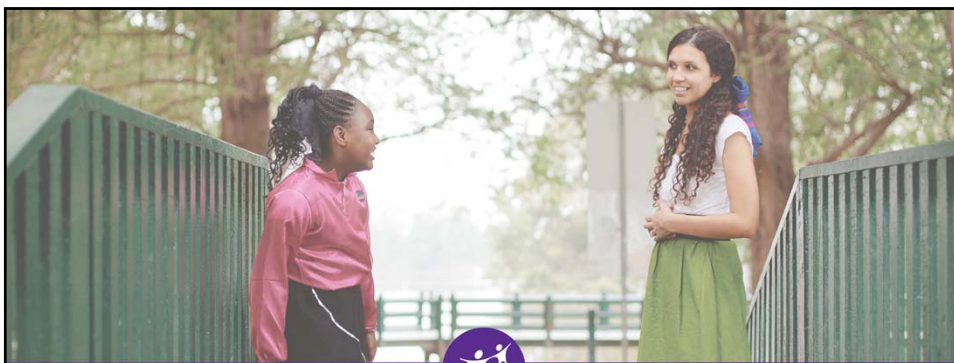

ROI TO THE CHILD AND COMMUNITY

Without Prevention:

- Each one of those 1.2 million dropouts costs taxpayers \$232,000.
- 57% of minority students don't go to college
- Juvenile justice facilities cost tax payers on average of \$240.99 per day per child;
- Among dropouts between the ages of 16 and 24, incarceration rates were 63 times higher than among college graduates³.

- 80% increase in academic achievement
- 99% High School Graduation Rate
- 89% College Enrollment Rate
- 100% refrain from crime and gang activity
- 100% stated that the only way they could have made it was from their mentor
