5	WHEREAS, the City of Riverside may offer and pay rewards as authorized by Section
6	53069.5 of the Government Code of the State of California; and
7	WHEREAS, Section 53069.5 specifically authorizes the City to offer and pay a reward, the
8	amount thereof to be determined by the City for information leading to the determination of the
9	identify of, and the apprehension of, any person whose willful misconduct results in injury or death
10	to any person; and
11	WHEREAS, on March 20, 2001, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 19873 approving
12	the Riverside Police Department's Reward Program and authorizing its implementation; and
13	WHEREAS, at approximately 12:26 a.m. on July 17, 2015, gunshots were heard and there
14	was a man down in the street on 12 th Street just east of Kansas Avenue; and
15	WHEREAS, the victim, who appeared to have been shot, was pronounced deceased at the
16	scene; and
17	WHEREAS, an autopsy revealed the victim had received multiple gunshot wounds,
18	resulting in his death; and
19	WHEREAS, the victim was identified as Juan Ramirez; and
20	WHEREAS, investigators with the Riverside Police Department have worked tirelessly;
21	however, no one has yet been arrested in connection with the crime; and
22	WHEREAS, investigators believe that there may be witnesses with information to this crime
23	who have not yet come forward; and
24	WHEREAS, the offer would be consistent with and is taken for the immediate protection of
25	public peace, health, and safety; and
26	WHEREAS, the offense was of such a nature or committed under special circumstances that
27	as a matter of public policy, the City of Riverside should provide a reward as an added inducement
28	or incentive for persons to come forth with information leading to the arrest of the perpetrator(s); and

WHEREAS, the City Council on August 26, 2015 approved Resolution Number 22902 effective for 60 days authorizing a reward in the amount of \$15,000 for information leading to determination of the identity of, and the apprehension of, any person responsible for the acts stated above; and

WHEREAS, a pursuant to the 60-day term of Resolution number 22902, the prior issued reward is now terminated by expiration of the time period set forth in the resolution offering the reward; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Riverside, California, that a new reward in the amount of \$10,000 is hereby approved and authorized for information leading to the determination of the identity of, and the apprehension of, any person responsible for the acts stated above.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the offer of reward by the City shall be effective for a period of sixty (60) days or for the term of any extension thereof which may be approved by the City Council prior to the termination of the offer of reward. An offer of reward by the City shall terminate by payment, by revocation, or by withdrawal thereof by the City Council by resolution, motion, or council report adopted by a majority vote of the City Council or by expiration of the time period set forth in the resolution offering the reward or any extension thereof which was approved by the City Council while the offer was otherwise effective.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all decisions with respect to the relevance or materiality of information received, whether or not utilized in establishing the determination of the identity of, and the apprehension of, any one or more persons provides a basis for the payment of a reward, are within the sole discretion of the City Council.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all determinations effective, or dispositive of the offer of reward, shall be within the sole discretion of the City Council and shall be final.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that pursuant to Section 53069.5, the person or persons responsible for the death of Juan Ramirez shall be liable for the amount of any reward paid pursuant

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1	to this Section and if the person is an unemancipated minor, his or her parent or guardian shall also
2	be liable for the amount.
