

1 RESOLUTION NO.

2 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE,
3 CALIFORNIA, OFFERING A REWARD IN THE AMOUNT OF \$10,000
4 FOR INFORMATION LEADING TO THE DETERMINATION OF THE
IDENTITY OF, AND THE APPREHENSION OF, THE PERSON OR
PERSONS RESPONSIBLE FOR THE DEATH OF DERRICK BUTLER.

5 WHEREAS, the City of Riverside may offer and pay rewards as authorized by Section 53069.5
6 of the Government Code of the State of California; and

7 WHEREAS, Section 53069.5 specifically authorizes the City to offer and pay a reward, the
8 amount thereof to be determined by the City for information leading to the determination of the
9 identify of, and the apprehension of, any person whose willful misconduct results in injury or death to
10 any person; and

11 WHEREAS, on March 20, 2001, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 19873 approving
12 the Riverside Police Department's Reward Program and authorizing its implementation; and

13 WHEREAS, at approximately 1:52 a.m. on July 18, 2015, Riverside Police Department
14 officers responded to 3527 Main Street regarding an adult male victim who had been shot; and

15 WHEREAS, the victim, was transported to the hospital where he succumbed to his injuries;
16 and

17 WHEREAS, the victim was identified as Derrick Butler; and

18 WHEREAS, investigators with the Riverside Police Department have worked tirelessly;
19 however, no one has yet been arrested in connection with the crime; and

20 WHEREAS, investigators believe that there may be witnesses with information to this crime
21 who have not yet come forward; and

22 WHEREAS, the offer would be consistent with and is taken for the immediate protection of
23 public peace, health, and safety; and

24 WHEREAS, the offense was of such a nature or committed under special circumstances that
25 as a matter of public policy, the City of Riverside should provide a reward as an added inducement or
26 incentive for persons to come forth with information leading to the arrest of the perpetrator(s); and

27 WHEREAS, the offense was especially heinous, atrocious, or cruel and manifested exceptional
28 depravity.

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Riverside,
2 California, that a reward in the amount of \$10,000 is hereby approved and authorized for information
3 leading to the determination of the identity of, and the apprehension of, any person responsible for the
4 acts stated above.

5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the offer of reward by the City shall be effective for a
6 period of sixty (60) days or for the term of any extension thereof which may be approved by the City
7 Council prior to the termination of the offer of reward. An offer of reward by the City shall terminate
8 by payment, by revocation, or by withdrawal thereof by the City Council by resolution, motion, or
9 council report adopted by a majority vote of the City Council or by expiration of the time period set
10 forth in the resolution offering the reward or any extension thereof which was approved by the City
11 Council while the offer was otherwise effective.

12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all decisions with respect to the relevance or materiality
13 of information received, whether or not utilized in establishing the determination of the identity of,
14 and the apprehension of, any one or more persons provides a basis for the payment of a reward, are
15 within the sole discretion of the City Council.

16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all determinations effective, or dispositive of the offer of
17 reward, shall be within the sole discretion of the City Council and shall be final.

18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that pursuant to Section 53069.5, the person or persons
19 responsible for the death of Derrick Butler shall be liable for the amount of any reward paid pursuant
20 to this Section and if the person is an unemancipated minor, his or her parent or guardian shall also be
21 liable for the amount.
