SUBJECT: MUSEUM NOT ACCEPTING DONATIONS UNTIL COMPLETION OF COLLECTION INVENTORY

ISSUE: Discussion of Museum's decision to stop accepting private donations into the Museum collections, effective January 2017, until the Museum inventory is complete.

RECCOMENDATION:

That the Museum Board receive and file this report.

BACKGROUND:

In November 2016, the American Alliance of Museums (AAM) decided to table the Riverside Metropolitan Museum's re-accreditation application due to several significant deficiencies. One of those is the substandard condition of the Museum's collection.

DISCUSSION:

Staff has been directed to stop accepting donations until the collection inventory is complete.

There are several problems with the museum's collection:

- 1. A complete inventory has not been conducted in the last 15 years.
- 2. According to AAM, there are items in the collection that are outside the scope of the museum's mission, and
- 3. The archives and artifacts in the museum's basement are improperly stored, based on museum standards, and are in danger of severe damage or loss.

Staff are working on a proposal and timeline for remedying this problem, and will provide the Board with an update at the next meeting.

FISCAL IMPACT:

There is no fiscal impact associated with this report.
