FIRETHORN AVENUE - ESTABLISHMENT OF 5-TON WEIGHT LIMIT RESTRICTION

Following discussion motion was made by Member Moran and seconded by Chair Angel recommending that the City Council approve establishment of a 5-ton weight limit restriction on Firethorn Avenue from the City limits to Irving Street, Motion carried unanimously.

MAGNOLIA AVENUE - REMOVAL OF 2-HOUR PARKING ZONE AND ESTABLISHMENT OF 1-HOUR PARKING ZONE

Following discussion motion was made by Member Timmons and seconded by Member Nelson recommending that the City Council approve the removal of the existing "2-Hour Parking between the Hours of 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Monday through Friday, except holidays" Zone on the south side of Magnolia Avenue from Van Buren Boulevard to east of Farnham Place; and the establishment of a "1-Hour Parking between the hours of 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Monday through Friday, except holidays" Zone on the south side of Magnolia Avenue from Van Buren Boulevard to 150 feet east of Farnham Place. Motion carried unanimously.

EL HIJO STREET - SPEED LIMIT ZONE ESTABLISHMENT

Following discussion motion was made by Member Nelson and seconded by Member Timmons recommending that the City Council adopt an ordinance to establish a 25 MPH speed limit zone on El Hijo Street from Arlington to Magnolia Avenues. Motion carried unanimously.
