SUBJECT: BID NO. 7451 FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF 2016 - 2017 MINOR STREETS MAINTENANCE, PHASE 1 TO SEQUEL CONTRACTORS, INC. IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,495,419.85

ISSUE:

Award a construction contract for Bid No. 7451 for the construction of the 2016 – 2017 Minor Streets Maintenance – Phase 1 street improvements at different locations throughout the City to Sequel Contractors, Inc., of Santa Fe Springs, California, in the amount of \$1,495,419.85.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

That the City Council:

1. Award a construction contract for Bid No. 7451 for 2016 - 2017 Minor Streets Maintenance Phase 1, to Sequel Contractors, Inc., of Santa Fe Springs, California, in the amount of \$1,495,419.85; and,
2. Authorize the City Manager, or his designee, to execute the construction contract with Sequel Contractors, Inc., including making minor non-substantial changes.

BACKGROUND:

The Public Works Department, continually receives service requests from City residents for various repairs or improvements to transportation infrastructure across the City. To obtain cost savings, Public Works routinely packages several items of similar nature together for bidding and completion of the work. The improvements detailed in this report are a result of such requests and primarily consist of asphalt concrete work.

DISCUSSION:

The project for the 2016 -2017 Minor Streets Maintenance – Phase 1 (Project) will construct various improvements at six different geographic locations (Attachment 1) throughout the City:

1. Repave Columbus Avenue, Jasmine Street, Ordway Street, Republic Street, Griffith Street, Denney Place, Fremont Street, Industrial Avenue, and Gage Street;

2. Repave three alleys between Mt Rubidoux Drive, Sixth Street, Pine Street, and Mission Inn Avenue;
3. Repave an alley between Linden Street, Rustin Avenue, and Tripoli Street;
4. Repave Stover Avenue between Gaylord Street and Country Lane, and Gaylord Street between Tyler Street and Stover Avenue;
5. Repave Madison Street between Magnolia and San Juan Avenues to address buckling and damaged signal loops; and
6. Restripe Century Avenue between Claridge and Shaker Drives.

On January 19, 2017, ten bids were received for the construction of the Project (Attachment 2). The lowest responsive bid was from Sequel Contractors, Inc., in the amount of \$1,495,419.85, which is 28.4% under the Engineer's Estimate.

The Purchasing Services Manager concurs with the award recommendation.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The estimated total Project cost including design, construction, construction engineering, and contingencies is \$1,750,000.00. Sufficient funds are available in Project Account number 9888427-440223 (Gas Tax – Minor Streets Rehab) to award the contract and complete the Project.
