Fenced Shelters



- 1.\$150 to \$200 per sq. feet.
- 2. On-going maintenance
- 3. Coordinate opening and locking
- 4. Displaces problem/does not solve
- 5. Penalizes all park users by requiring a fee for access
- 6. Not esthetically pleasing
