**SUBJECT: PLAYGROUND SAFETY SURFACING REPLACEMENTS**

**ISSUE:**

Update on recent playground safety surfacing replacements at various City parks.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

That the Park and Recreation Commission provide input and receive the report for file.

**BACKGROUND:**

Over the past two years, the Parks Division has prioritized replacement of worn rubberized playground surfacing and replenishment of uniform wood fiber, in order to maintain the City's playgrounds in a safe condition for public use. The attached presentation provides a look at the various types of surfacing, the process for removal and replacement, and the locations at which this work was completed.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

There is no fiscal impact associated with this report. The Parks Refurbishment account provided funding for the uniform wood fiber improvements. Parks Refurbishment, Cell Tower, California Development Block Grant, and Riverwalk Landscape Maintenance District provided funding for the rubber surfacing improvements.
