**SUBJECT**: WATER HIGHLIGHTS – February 2017

Domestic water production for the month of February 2017 totaled 2,544 acre-feet (829 million gallons), with the following resource mix:

Bunker Hill Basin: 81%Riverside Basin: 19%Purchased Water: 0%

Peak water usage for the month of February 2017, was 34 million gallons per day (mgd) and occurred on February 1st.

Under the Cooperative Agreement for Water Production and Conveyance with Western Municipal Water District, 414 AF of potable water and 0 AF of irrigation water were delivered to WMWD.


There were no significant events for the water system in February 2017.
