

ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE,
CALIFORNIA, AMENDING SECTION 2.36.040 OF THE
RIVERSIDE MUNICIPAL CODE – CLASSIFIED SERVICE

The City Council of the City of Riverside does ordain as follows:

Section 1: Section 2.36.040 of the Riverside Municipal Code is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:

“2.36.040 Classified service.

Classified service. The classified service of the City shall include all regular full-time and regular part-time officers and employees, except the following:

- A. Elective officers;
- B. Persons appointed by the City Council, including City Manager, City Clerk and City Attorney;
- C. Persons appointed by the City Manager to the position of Assistant City Manager, and all department heads;
- D. Persons appointed by the Mayor;
- E. Persons appointed by the Chief of Police to position of Assistant Chief of Police and Deputy Chief of Police;
- F. Persons appointed by the City Attorney to the position of Chief Assistant City Attorney ~~and by the City Clerk;~~
- G. Persons appointed by the Fire Chief to the position of Deputy Fire Chief;
- H. Persons appointed by the City Clerk to the position of Assistant City Clerk; and
- I. Any other position so stated as non-classified in the City Salary Schedule Report.

Section 2: The City Council has reviewed the matter and, based upon the facts and information contained in the staff reports, administrative record, and written and oral testimony, hereby finds that this ordinance is not subject to CEQA pursuant to Sections 15060(c)(2), 15060(c)(3) and/or 15061(b)(3) of the State CEQA Guidelines, California Code of Regulations,

1 Title 14, Chapter 3, in that it will not result in a direct or reasonably foreseeable indirect physical
2 change in the environment nor have a significant impact on the environment.

3 Section 3: The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this ordinance and cause
4 publication once in a newspaper of general circulation in accordance with Section 414 of the
5 Charter of the City of Riverside. This ordinance shall become effective on the 30th day after the
6 date of its adoption.
