## RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, (1) DECLARING THAT THE REPAIR OF THE FAILING SEWER FORCE MAIN AT ALESSANDRO BOULEVARD AND TRAUTWEIN ROAD IS OF URGENT NECESSITY FOR THE PRESERVATION OF LIFE. HEALTH, AND PROPERTY PURSUANT TO CHARTER SECTION 1109; (2) AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH C.P. CONSTRUCTION CO., INC., FOR THE EVALUATION AND REPAIR OF A RUPTURED SEWER FORCE MAIN AT TRAUTWEIN ROAD AND BERRY ROAD, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$57,145.52; AND (3) AUTHORIZING THE PROCUREMENT OF A DESIGN-**ENTITY** BUILD TO DESIGN AND CONSTRUCT **EMERGENCY** REHABILITATION OF THE SEWER FORCE MAIN AT TRAUTWEIN ROAD AND ALESSANDRO BOULEVARD IN AN AMOUNT BETWEEN \$2,500,000 AND \$3,500,000.

WHEREAS, on March 18, 2017, Public Works staff discovered a ruptured sewer force main at Trautwein Road and Berry Road involving approximately 605,000 gallons; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department immediately procured the services of C.P. Construction Co., Inc. to perform emergency evaluation and repair of the sewer main to contain the spill; and

WHEREAS, the cost of completed emergency repairs was \$57,145.52; and

WHEREAS, in order to avoid public health and environmental hazards, it was necessary to procure the services of C.P. Construction Co., Inc. immediately without the use of competitive procurement procedures pursuant to Resolution No. 22576 and Charter section 1109; and

WHEREAS, the March 2017 rupture was the second recent rupture on this line, as on December 4, 2016, a similar rupture occurred nearby on Alessandro Boulevard resulting in 1.5 million gallons spilled; and

WHEREAS, after the March 2017 rupture, the Public Works staff retained Carrollo Engineers to evaluate the entire sewer pipeline for that area; and

WHEREAS, in a March 30, 2017 report, Carrollo Engineers found that the entire pipeline at Trautwein Road and Alessandro Boulevard was in imminent danger of failure and recommended that emergency rehabilitation take place immediately; and

WHEREAS, Public Works Department staff concurs with Carrollo Engineers' report; and

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WHEREAS, an additional sewer main rupture would be a danger to public and environmental health, could result in fines assessed against the City, and would result in the necessity for additional emergency repairs at a higher cost; and

WHEREAS, the recommended emergency rehabilitation must take place immediately to avoid additional ruptures, as such a design-build contractor must be retained to design and construct the necessary repairs; and

WHEREAS, the costs to complete the emergency rehabilitation is estimated to be between \$2,500,000 and \$3,500,000; and

WHEREAS, the sewer force main repairs are of urgent necessity for the preservation of life, health, and property, such that the competitive procurement requirements of Charter section 1109 and Resolution No. 22576 should be waived so that a design-build contractor can be retained to perform the emergency rehabilitation as soon as possible; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Riverside, California, as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>: The above recitals are incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2: On the basis of the foregoing recitals and the staff report accompanying this Resolution, it is hereby found and declared that repair of the 16-inch Sewer Force Main at Trautwein Road and Berry Road was of urgent necessity for the preservation of life, health, and property, and that the repairs procured without competitive bidding pursuant to Resolution No. 22576 and Charter section 1109 are hereby approved.

Section 3: The City Manager, or his designee, is authorized to execute the appropriate contract documents with C.P. Construction Co., Inc. for the necessary work for \$57,145.52.

Section 4: Additionally, on the basis of the foregoing recitals, the report prepared by Carrollo Engineers, and the staff report accompanying this Resolution, it is hereby found and declared that the emergency rehabilitation of the sewer force main is of urgent necessity for the preservation of life, health, and property, and that the design and construction of repairs may be procured from a qualified,

1	experienced, and available contractor without competitive bidding pursuant to Resolution No. 22576
2	and Charter section 1109.
3	Section 5: The City Manager, or his designee, is authorized to execute the appropriate contract
4	documents with the design-build entity ultimately selected for the project to design and complete the
5	necessary work in an amount between \$2,500,000 and \$3,500,000.
