

1 RESOLUTION NO.

2 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE,
3 CALIFORNIA, AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 22451 KNOWN AS THE
4 MASTER PARKING SCHEDULE RESOLUTION TO REVISE THE
EXISTING PREFERENTIAL PARKING ZONE ON INDIANA AVENUE.

5 WHEREAS, the Public Works Department is proposing revision of the existing
6 Preferential Parking Zone ("PPZ") on the north side of Indiana Avenue west of Winstrom Street
7 due to the recent removal of residential structures at the properties located at 7715, 7725 and 7735
8 Indiana Avenue. As a result of these changes, revision of the PPZ boundaries is necessary to
9 reduce the zone to encompass the only remaining residential property within the zone located at
10 7705 Indiana Avenue; and

11 WHEREAS, the proposed revision would eliminate the PPZ in from of the now vacant
12 lots and provide additional on-street parking opportunities for area businesses while maintaining
13 the PPZ and preserving parking for residents and their guests and the frontage of 7705 Indiana
14 Avenue; and

15 WHEREAS, on March 1, 2017, the Transportation Board unanimously recommended
16 approval of the proposed revision of the boundaries of the existing PPZ on the north side of
17 Indiana Avenue west of Winstrom Street.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Riverside,
19 California, as follows:

20 Section 1: The recitals set forth above are incorporated herein by reference.

21 Section 2: That the Master Parking Schedule is hereby amended by revising the
22 boundaries of the existing "No Parking 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. Daily" Preferential Parking Zone
23 on the north side of Indiana Avenue from "285 feet west of Winstrom Street to 260 feet westerly
24 thereof" to "285 feet west of Winstrom Street to 65 feet westerly thereof."

25 Section 3: That the provisions of this resolution shall be operative only when signs are
26 erected on that portion of the street set forth in Section 2 above, giving notice of the parking
27 limitations or prohibitions herein established.

Section 4: The provisions of this amendment shall be operative as of the date of adoption of this resolution.
