SUBJECT: BOARD AND COMMISSION RESIGNATIONS

ISSUE:

Accept resignations of Donna L. Mitas from the Commission on Aging and Jennifer D. Binkley from the Metropolitan Museum Board.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

That the City Council:

1. Accept the resignations of Donna L. Mitas (Ward 6) from the Commission on Aging and Jennifer D. Binkley (Citywide) from the Metropolitan Museum Board, effective immediately; and
2. Request the City Clerk to process the vacancies.

BACKGROUND/LEGISLATIVE HISTORY:

On March 22 and 27, 2017, the City Clerk's Office received resignations from Donna L. Mitas of the Commission on Aging and Jennifer D. Binkley of the Metropolitan Museum Board, respectively, effective immediately. Their terms expire on March 1, 2020. Ms. Mitas held the Ward 6 seat on the Commission on Aging. Ms. Binkley held the Citywide seat on the Metropolitan Museum Board.

Pursuant to Charter Section 802, each board and commission must have at least one representative from each of the Council Wards. The vacancies created by the resignation of Ms. Mitas and Ms. Binkley will be filled by registered voters in compliance with the Charter requirement.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Recruitment and appointment costs are included annually in the City Clerk's budget.
