SUBJECT: PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE BAIL SCHEDULE FOR PARKING

VIOLATIONS - RESOLUTION

ISSUE:

Adopt a resolution to amend the bail schedule for parking violations of specific Riverside Municipal Codes (RMC) and California Vehicle Codes (CVC) sections, updating the language to make it consistent with recent amendments made to RMC Title 9 and Title 10.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the City Council adopt a Resolution amending the Bail Schedule for parking violations.

BACKGROUND:

On December 20, 2016, City Council adopted Ordinance No. 7362 amending Titles 8-17 of the RMC where updates were made for congruence with current law and to incorporate current practices.

DISCUSSION:

Due to this amendment, there are four sections within the parking bail schedule that were affected when the RMC was updated.

The following chart lists the current and proposed bail violation descriptions, which with these changes, will mirror the language in the RMC.

The proposed resolution would make the bail schedule (Exhibit A) language consistent with the updates of Title 9 and 10 as they directly relate to the parking bail schedule. No changes to the existing bail amounts are proposed.

The amended Bail Schedule, if approved by the City Council, will ensure the language is current and consistent with the RMC.
