SUBJECT: ACCEPTANCE OF KIWANIS CLUB OF UPTOWN RIVERSIDE DONATION TO SUPPORT FIRE DEPARTMENT PUBLIC EDUCATION PROGRAMMING – SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION

ISSUE:

Accept a donation from Kiwanis Club of Uptown Riverside in the amount of \$5,000 to support Fire Department public education programming.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

That the City Council:

- 1. Accept a \$5,000 donation from Kiwanis Club of Uptown Riverside; and
- 2. Authorize an increase in revenue in the amount of \$5,000 and appropriate expenditures in the same amount in a project account to be established by the Finance Department.

BACKGROUND:

The Kiwanis Club of Uptown Riverside supports local community organizations, including public safety, through fundraising and community service hours.

DISCUSSION:

On March 21, 2017, the Kiwanis Club of Uptown Riverside presented the Riverside Fire Department with a check in the amount of \$5,000. If accepted by the City Council, the Fire Department will use this generous donation to pay for fire and life safety public education marketing, printing costs, and related educational needs. Acceptance of this donation supports the Fire Department's mission to "...protect life, property, and the environment by providing exceptional and progressive, all-hazard emergency services, public education, and safety programs."

FISCAL IMPACT:

There is no net general fund impact in accepting the \$5,000 donation from Kiwanis Club of Uptown Riverside. The donation revenue will be fully offset by expenses related to support fire and life safety public education marketing, printing costs, and related educational needs.
