# SUBJECT: THE COMMUNITY FOUNDATION CLARK FUND ANNUAL CONTRIBUTION -SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION

# ISSUE:

Approve acceptance of the 2017 and prior annual contributions from The Community Foundation's Charles F. and Wilhelmina E. Clark Fund in the amount of \$33,516.

#### **RECOMMENDATIONS**:

That the City Council:

- 1. Approve acceptance of the 2017 annual contribution from The Community Foundation Charles F. and Wilhelmina E. Clark Fund in the amount of \$8,053;
- 2. Retroactively approve acceptance of the 2003, 2010 and 2016 contributions from The Community Foundation Charles F. and Wilhelmina E. Clark Fund in the combined amount of \$25,463; and
- 3. Increase revenues and appropriate expenditures in the amount of \$33,516 to the Clark Fund Botany Gallery (Account No. 5305000-450011).

# BOARD RECOMMENDATION:

On April 12, 2017, the Metropolitan Museum Board unanimously voted to recommend that the City Council:

- 1. Approve acceptance of the 2017 annual contribution from The Community Foundation Charles F. and Wilhelmina E. Clark Fund in the amount of \$8,053;
- Retroactively approve acceptance of the 2003, 2010, and 2016 contributions from The Community Foundation Charles F. and Wilhelmina E. Clark Fund in the combined amount of \$25,463; and
- 3. Increase revenues and appropriate expenditures in the amount of \$33,516 to the Clark Fund Botany Gallery (Account No. 5305000-450011).

#### BACKGROUND:

Dr. Charles Clark, a Riverside resident and scientist with the United States Department of Agriculture, established a Museum fund for botanical purposes. Dr. Clark died in 1949 and the Clark Fund was established in 1950. The Community Foundation administers the endowed Charles F. and Wilhelmina E. Clark Fund. Each year, the interest on this account is contributed to the Riverside Metropolitan Museum to be used for botanical purposes. For 2017, the annual contribution is \$8,053.

Annual contributions of \$9,668 in 2003, \$7,660 in 2010, and \$8,135 in 2016 were received, but not presented to City Council for approval; these contributions total \$25,463.

#### **DISCUSSION:**

In addition to the years that contributions were not taken to City Council for approval, review of the Clark Fund account revealed that there were years in which the annual contribution was approved by the City Council, but not transferred into the Museum's expenditure account. This has been remedied as of March 15, 2017.
